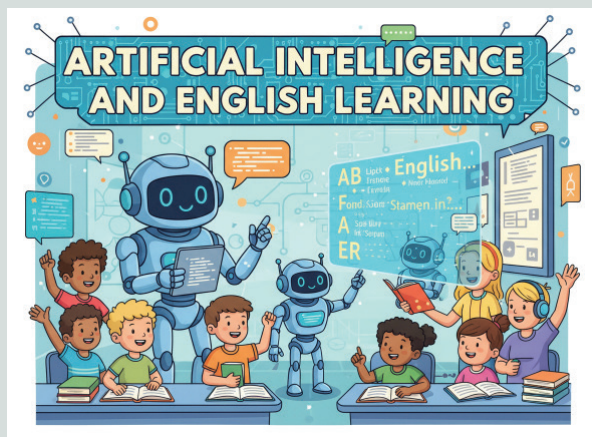


Artificial Intelligence & English Learning
